- c) Scoring breakdown

 - 3rd Place- 80 pts
 - 4th Place- 70 pts
 - 5th Place- 60 pts
 - 6th Place- 50 pts
 - 7th Place- 40 pts
 - 8th Place- 30 pts
 - 9th Place- 20 pts
 - 10th Place- 10 pts

-10 events

- a) 7 tournaments (Icebreaker, Crowdaddy, thongalong, etc) \$30-35 entry
- b) 3 flex tournaments (play in your own group pay \$10 turn in scorecard)
- c) 3 of 7 will be MAJORS and worth *double points*
- d) Top 30 Point Leaders qualify for "THE TROUT"
 - CMGA Point Championship
 - Bag tags go to the Top 30
 - NO ENTRY FEE
- e) Winner gets name on the coveted TROUT CUP

Super Bowl Scramble-

2-man scramble, pick your own partner and bring your "A" game before kickoff. Depending on the amount of teams we could have 2 flights.

Cost: \$30/man

Ice Breaker-

4-man scramble with the MGA making the teams in a A-B-C-D team format, which gives you a chance to meet golfers outside of your normal group. Everybody will get points and a few (Top 3 Teams) will get clubhouse credit.

Cost: \$30/man

March Madness-

Handicapped individual event. This will give you a chance to show everybody how much sand you have in your pockets!! Top 10 get points and clubhouse cabbage!

Cost: \$30

Me and My Green Jacket-

This is the first "Flex" tournament of the year, and here is how it works. You pay \$10 in the clubhouse and play in your normal group on Saturday and you pick a PGA Tour player to be your partner. Turn your scorecard in after your round signed by someone in your group and pick your partner for the final round of the MASTERS. Both scores will be averaged to come up with a winner.

Cost: \$10

Who's Your Crawdaddy?-

Our first Major of the year...an individual tournament where you get to pick a pro playing in the third round of THE PLAYERS Tournament. Scores get put together and the Top 10 get points and clubhouse cabbage.

Cost: \$35

Bushwhacker Member-Guest-

Our chance to showcase our club and entertain a customer or goof friend in a match play format that is truly a priceless weekend. Skills challenge, great dinner, great prizes, and a chance to play in a match play event like no other.

Cost: \$300/team

Thong-A-Long-

3-man scramble that is the 2nd MAJOR of the year. Bring your own team and get ready to battle it out. It should be a classic after the dust settles.

Cost: \$35/man

Me & Ye Old Cup-

Flex #2 coincides with the British Open, so you pick a pro for his Sunday round and then play in your normal Saturday group.

Cost: \$10

Tiger & Me To Repeat-

Flex #3 coincides with the PGA Championship, so you pick a pro for his Sunday round and then play in your normal Saturday group.

Cost: \$10

Did You Say Stableford?-

That's right high point total wins! A modified stableford, CMGA style. Booyah on this as this closes out our season before the TROUT.

Cost: \$30/man
